to increase early HIV/STI diagnosis and treatment among the most vulnerable groups."

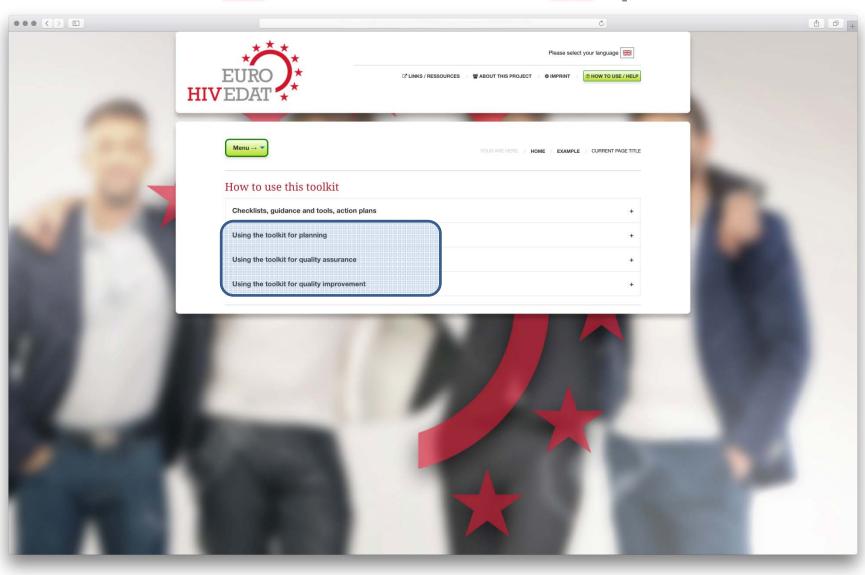
Workpackage 7:

MSM Checkpoints

- Implementation of many CBVCT centers that specifically address MSM in Europe
- Checkpoints CBVCT and health centers for MSM
- Great diversity
 - Adapted to local needs, local conditions and local restrictions
 - Great variety in services
 - Different structures

- Internetbased Toolkit to support NGOs that recently established or want to start a CBVCT Service/Checkpoint for MSM
- Main information needed
 - for planning and operating a Checkpoint
 - to assure quality of services
- Systematic self-evaluation-tool
- Not adapted to a specific health system or environment
- Suggests to take into account what is locally needed

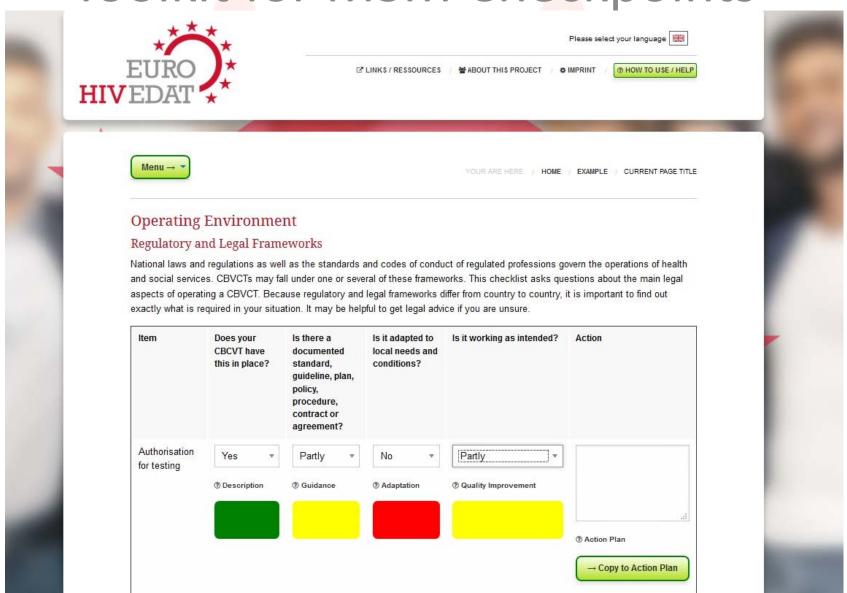


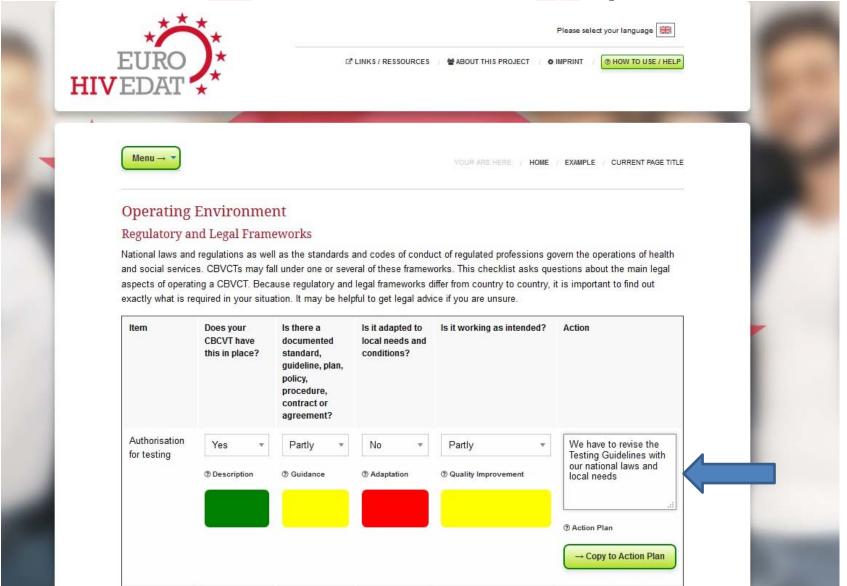


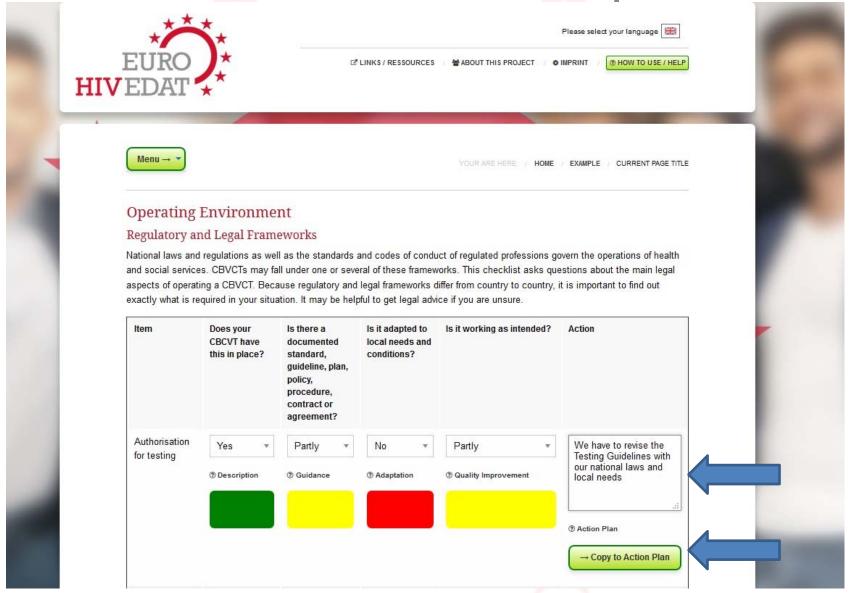


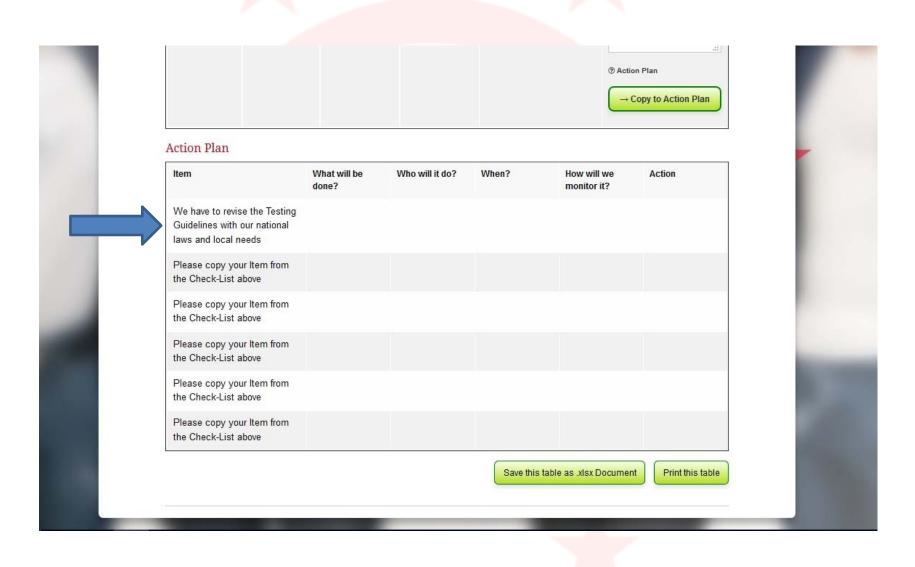












Conclusion
