

Guidelines for poster presentations

All posters should be hung up during the entire conference. The author is required to be present in the poster area on Monday, 2nd November between 18:05-19:00 and on Tuesday, 3rd November between 9:30-10:00.

Delegates are advised to organize posters into sections, including:

- Title/authors/affiliations
- Introduction
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusions

Please insert the poster number (abstract number) in the top left-hand corner.

Preparation

- We recommend that you make your poster in **A0 size (84 cm wide and 118,9 cm high)**. None of the material (label, figures, charts, tables, summary, etc.) may extend beyond the poster board surface;
- Lettering for poster titles and authors should be at least 60 point and easy to read. Lettering in the body text should be at least 24 point, and in references be at least 20 point;
- Illustrations should be clearly visible from a distance and less detailed than those used for screen presentations. Using colour may clarify an image, but be sure that the background and font color are compatible for easy reading (e.g. do not use yellow or gold);
- Poster content should be easy-to-read and scan;
- The poster must be fully prepared when you arrive at the conference;
- Do not mount your work on very heavy cardboard, as this may be too difficult to fix to the wall board. Materials to hang your poster on the poster board will be available in the poster exhibition area;
- Abstract numbers (poster numbers) will be displayed at the top of the relevant poster board.

Presentation

- Posters should be mounted on the 2nd November 2026 from 11:00-15:00.
- Posters should be removed between 15:00-18:00 on the 3rd November 2026. Posters not removed by this time will be discarded. Posters and other material will not be sent to you after the conference
- Please forward a pdf version of your poster to the conference secretariat hephiv.rigshospitalet@regionh.dk. All posters will be uploaded to the HepHIV 2026 Dublin Conference website after the conference.
